YOUTH SPORTS BURSARIES

AWARD POLICY

The purpose of these awards is to facilitate achievement by aspiring young performers who have ability and potential to achieve success in their chosen sport at Provincial, National or International levels.

1. Application for an award will only be considered from:
 - Individuals resident in the Antrim Borough
 - Individuals attending school or college in the Antrim Borough
 - Individuals who are a member of a club in the Antrim Borough

2. Awards up to a maximum of £500 are available to assist individual young people with the costs of training, travel and equipment.

3. Applications will only be accepted on an official form available from Antrim Sports Advisory Association. A verbal presentation must be made to the Awards Committee, by either the applicant or some other person on the applicant's behalf in the presence of the applicant, which shall detail the use to which the Award shall be put.

4. Applicants must be under 25 years of age in the calendar year of the Award being made.

5. Awards shall be made quarterly with applications closing on the last day of February, May, August and November.

6. Antrim Sports Advisory Association will be responsible for the dissemination of the Awards to individuals who in turn shall be required to demonstrate that the award has been properly used. Antrim Sports Advisory Association shall be entitled to recover an Award should it be established that it has not been used in an appropriate way.

7. A decision to make an award will be based on:-
 - Ability of applicant
 - Need of applicant
 - Benefit to sport in Antrim
 - Record of commitment / service to school and club.
